Thank you for visiting our page and showing interest in Wuerth Elektronik Stelvio Kontek S.p.A. We would like to tell you about our privacy and data protection policy for visitors (i.e. users) of our website.



TYPE OF DATA PROCESSED AND PURPOSES OF PROCESSING

✓ **Voluntarily submitted data**

Personal data provided by users through communications sent to the e-mail addresses and/or information request forms on this website, including requests for sending informative material (brochures, catalogues, etc.), will be used for the sole purpose of responding to any messages and/or requests we receive.

✓ **Browsing data**

The computer systems and software procedures used to run this website during normal operations acquire certain personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This information is not collected to be associated with identified data subjects, but by their very nature could enable the identification of users through processing and association with data held by third parties.

This category of data includes IP addresses, or the domain names of the computers used by visitors connecting to the website, the time of the request, the method used to submit a request to the server, the size of the file obtained as a response, the numeric status code issued by the server in response to the request (successful, error, etc.), and other parameters regarding the user's operating system and computer environment.

These data are used for the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information on the use of the website and to control that the website is working properly. The data are erased immediately after processing.

The data in question could be used to ascertain responsibility in the event of computer related offenses causing damage to our website.

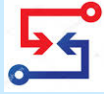
✓ **Cookies**

This website uses cookies which are text files stored on the user's computer or that enable access to information on the user's computer. Cookies make it possible to store information about visitors' preferences, verify the correct operation of the website and improve its functionality by customizing the content of the web pages based on the type of browser used. They also make your online experience easier by automating certain procedures (e.g. login, website language). Last, but not least, they help analyse how our visitors use our website.

This website uses the following categories of cookies:

- ❖ **technical cookies**, used for the sole purpose of transmitting an electronic communication, to ensure proper website performance and a user-friendly visit. Moreover, they serve to distinguish you from other users of our website in order to provide the right service requested (Login), and for website security purposes. Some of these cookies are erased when the browser is closed (session cookies); others have a longer duration (such as the cookie required to retain the user's consent regarding the use of cookies). Consent is not required for these cookies;
- ❖ **analytics cookies**, used directly by the website operator to collect information in aggregate form about the number of users and how they visit the site. They are similar to technical cookies provided the service is anonymised;
- ❖ **profiling and marketing cookies**, used solely by third parties other than the owner of this website to collect information on the users' behaviour during browsing, their interests and consumption habits. They also serve to provide personalised advertising.

By clicking ACCEPT on the banner shown the first time visiting or browsing the website, the visitor expressly consents to the use of cookies and similar technologies, and in particular to the registration of such cookies on his or her computer for the above mentioned purposes, or to access - via cookies - to information on his or her computer.



OPTIONAL PROVISION OF DATA

Notwithstanding the information provide above on browsing data and cookies, the user is free to choose whether or not to provide personal data when requesting information and/or services. However, failure to provide this data may make it impossible to fulfil the request.



DATA PROCESSING VENUE AND ENTITIES WITH ACCESS TO DATA

Our website is physically hosted by Publifarm Srl. The processing related to the web services on this website are carried out at our headquarters in Oggiono (LC) - via Al Mognago, 49 - ITALY, exclusively by employees or collaborators that the Controller has appointed as in charge of data processing, or - where appropriate- by third party technical service providers who occasionally perform maintenance tasks.

No data is disclosed or disseminated, unless the communication is imposed by law or by order of judicial authorities.



METHOD AND DURATION OF PROCESSING

Personal data are processed using automated tools, only for the period of time required to achieve the purposes for which they were collected. Specific security measures are observed to prevent data loss, unlawful or incorrect use, and unauthorized access.

Data shall be retained for the time required by law, never longer than 24 months, limited to the need to:

- ❖ provide periodic services;
- ❖ possibly sign up to newsletters, for which an immediate unsubscribe function is always provided.
- ❖ meet legal and fiscal obligations.



RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT AND LODGING COMPLAINTS WITH THE SUPERVISORY AUTHORITY

Data subjects may contact Wuerth Elektronik Stelvio Kontek S.p.A. by email at protezione-dei-dati@stelvio-kontek.com to ask the Company for access to data relating to the data subject, to have inaccurate data erased or corrected, to have incomplete data completed, to have data erased, to obtain restriction of processing in the cases provided under art. 18 of the GDPR, as well as to object to the processing carried out for the legitimate interests pursued by the controller.

The data subject, in cases where processing is based on consent or a contract and is carried out using automated tools has the right to receive, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, the data, as well as, where technically feasible, to transmit those data to another controller without hindrance.

The data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority in the Member State in their place of habitual residence or work or the State in which the alleged breach occurred.

The data subject has the right to withdraw his or her consent given at any time for marketing purposes and to object to the processing of the data processed for the same purposes. The data subject may opt to be contacted only by "traditional" methods for the above purposes and therefore indicate that he or she objects only to receiving communications via automated methods.

- ❖ the core activities of the Controller or the Processor do not consist of processing on a large scale of special categories of data pursuant to Article 9 and personal data relating to criminal convictions and offences referred to in Article 10;
- ❖ does not fall under the categories laid down in article 37(1) of the GDPR

and that Wuerth Elektronik eiSos has appointed a DPO, which acts as a point of reference for the companies belonging to the Group, a decision was made not to appoint a data protection officer.
